Problem that AWS tackles

Endotracheal intubation is the 3rd most common medical procedure in Hospitals around the world. Globally, +100 million people are intubated every year. Yet, 45% of intubations in critically ill patients end in major complications such as severe hypoxemia, cardiovascular instability or cardiac arrest. Besides, 1 out of 3 anesthesiology claims are for dental injuries due to the intubation process.

Solution that AWS provides

They Airway Shield: A new medical device that provides safer endotracheal intubation by:

- 1) protecting the patient from injuries in the mucosa and dental pieces,
- 2) protecting the clinician from the aerosols, and
- 3) effectively guiding the tube to the patient's trachea.

Job description

AWS has just started to commercialize the Airway Shield, the world's first effective guide barrier device for endotracheal intubations. The actual challenge is to further develop the Airway Shield by continuous iterations, analyzing its usability and integrating feedback from the clinicians. There are also other developments and variations of the Airway Shield being developed and in the concept stage.
